RAPE/KALE HYBRID BRASSICA

WHY CHOOSE UNICORN?

Unicorn is a new Rape / Kale brassica Hybrid bred to produce a quality feed in a short period of time. Unicorn will produce a nutritious feed for dairy, beef or lamb production and can be utilised summer, autumn or winter.

REGROWTH POTENTIAL

Crops of **Unicorn** sown in May and June have the potential to “Bounce back” after an initial grazing, this can be achieved by “back fencing” the initial crop and retaining a 20-cm stem with leaf nodules that will allow bounce back regrowth to occur. *The plants ability to bounce back can be greatly influenced by the weather and grazing management.

GROWING GUIDELINES

Unicorn can be sown from May to August. For best results drill the seed into a firm moist seedbed @ 5 kilo per hectare. To ensure maximum yield apply fertiliser into the seedbed NPK 80:25:50 kg/ha. **Unicorn** can benefit from Slurry and FYM applications prior to drilling.

FEEDING

May drilled crops should be ready to graze in 12 weeks and produce approx. 30-35 tonnes of leafy forage per hectare. Crops are best strip grazed.

Sowing and Growing	Feeding
Sow May – End August	30-35 tonnes per hectare
5 kilos per hectare	Graze 12 week from sowing
NPK 80: 25: 50 kg/Ha
