


Mantara is the highest yielding maple pea on the PGRO Recommended List 2019. The variety produces a rounded grain of a light brown colour, suitable for the niche pigeon feed market.

 Mantara is the highest yielding maple pea on the PGRO Recommended List, 4% higher than Rose.
